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

There is a form of misery that is right in front of our eyes that we choose not to see. Behind the idyllic image of major events with television audiences in the billions, competitive sports worldwide hides a tragic reality: the broken lives of hundreds of thousands of children around the world. We know that authoritarian regimes subject their future champions to extreme training conditions, but what we are less aware of is that those methods now set the tone for elite sports in western democracies.

Over the past few years, dozens of studies conducted by pediatricians, psychologists and sports sociologists have piled up, and their conclusions converge: in the vast majority of cases, high-level sports training abuses children. Defenders of children's rights are also drawing attention to the fact that there are no specific rules in place to protect children training for elite sports. After the doping and corruption scandals in the early 2000s and the recent revelations about the epidemic of sexual abuse, the abuse of elite child athletes is going to be the next revelation shaking up the world of sports.

- In anticipation of the 2024 Olympic Games, this film is a call to action to respect children's rights in the world of sports.
- An international investigation that will shed light on the machinery that is crushing future champions' bodies and minds. Filmed in several countries (France, Germany, Norway, Canada, Switzerland, UK and more) and interviews with sport experts, doctors, NGO representatives and athletes.
- ▶ Pierre-Emmanuel Luneau-Daurignac, the director (previous credits include End Game: Breaking the Silence sold in over 20 territories), was one of the first journalists in the world to sound the alarm about an epidemic of abuse in sports. He works regularly with several institutions on issues affecting sports (Council of Europe, National convention on sexual violence in sport...).

In the early 1970s, when Portugal was still under the authoritarian rule of Europe's longest-lasting dictatorship, a handful of military officers decided to risk everything to try to free their country. In the shadow of the regime, they devised a coup d'état like no other. From that coup, a revolution blossomed: the Carnation Revolution.

50 years after that day of insurrection – April 25, 1974 – this documentary, which unspools like a historical thriller, aims to explore the multi-facetted events that would change the fate of an entire nation.




THE WAR OF THE WORLDS THE PROPHETIC NOVEL

First published in 1898, H.G. Wells's *The War of the Worlds* was a veritable literary and cultural revolution. It laid the foundations for modern sci-fi by telling the first-ever story of an alien invasion.

A political and moral fable, the novel uses science fiction as a tool to raise our awareness and alert the modern world to the dangers and risks inherent in industrial, scientific and technological progress. It is high time to rediscover this seminal book.

- ➤ Revised and distorted time and time again, from John Wyndham's terrifying *The Day of the Triffids* (1951) to Tim Burton's parodic *Mars Attacks* (1996), via the "fake news" broadcast by Orson Welles (1938) and Steven Spielberg's adaptation (2005), *The War of the Worlds* is indisputably part of the literary canon.
- A visionary work: as a scientist and a politically committed person, Wells signed an anti-imperialist, anti-colonialist, anti-speciesist and environmental manifesto that resonates with contemporary issues and ideas.
- Interviews with NASA scientists, writers and filmmakers; film excerpts, Wells's essays, notebooks and more: we have manifold resources at our disposal that will allow us to shed new and contemporary light on this important novel.
